OFTEN I HAVE BEEN ASKED WHAT IS TAM WITH REGARDS TO HOW IT EXISTED, AND ITS ROLE AS A TECHNICAL PROFESSIONAL AND CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANISATION. QUESTIONS OFTEN ARISE ON WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE AND ROLE OF TAM IN THE TECHNOLOGICAL AND PROFFESIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF TECHNICAL CAPITAL OF OUR COUNTRY. MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC OFTEN RECOGNISE **IEM** THE INSTITUTION OF ENGINEERS MALAYSIA AS THE PROFESSIONAL TECHNICAL ASSOCIATION OF THE COUNTRY BUT NOT TAM.

A QUICK WALK DOWN HISTORY.

TAM WAS FOUNDED IN 1946 MORE THAN 70 OVER YEARS AGO AS AN ORGANISATION FOR ALL LEVELS AND DISCIPLINES OF TECHNNICAL PERSONNEL FROM PROFESSIONALS TO STUDENTS AND ANYONE WHOSE CAREERS ARE TECHNOLOGICAL AND TECHNICAL IN NATURE. INADVERTENTLY THIS INCLUDES THE FIELD OF ENGINEERING.

IN THOSE DAYS TAM WAS LOOSELY CONCEIVED AS A FORUM FOR THE DISCUSSION OF MUTUAL PROBLEMS BY MEN FROM ALL WALKS OF THE TECHNICAL AND SCIENTIFIC COMMUNITY DURING THE COUNTRY'S PRE-INDEPENDENCE. INTERESTINGLY THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT (PWD OR JKR) OF PERAK, THROUGH THE INITIATIVE OF THEIR TECHNICAL LEADERSHIP (WHO WERE ANG MO) FORMED THE PERAK TECHNICAL ASSOCIATION IN 1935. THE SELANGOR TECHNICAL ASSOCIATION WAS FORMED IN 1937. THESE ASSOCIATIONS PROVIDED A PRELIMINARY PLATFORM FOR TECHNICAL AND PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES IN THOSE DAYS, AND THE EVENTUAL FORMATION OF A TECHNICAL COMMUNITY WAS BORN. THIS HAD NOW MANIFESTS ITSELF INTO ORGANISATIONS LIKE THE INSTITUTION OF ENGINEERS MALAYSIA, (IEM), AND THE TECHNOLOGICAL
